#### **Overview**

The project is building upon existing work by expanding School Travel Planning, piloting a Walking School Bus, and strengthening the commitment of local stakeholders through formal agreements, a revitalized regional advisory committee and a new Active School Travel charter.

## **Project highlights**

- » Piloting a Walking School Bus pilot at four schools using a paid leader model to teach pedestrian safety and build parental confidence in their children's ability to walk to school.
- » Supporting cycling to school by installing new bike racks at 15 schools and developing new guidelines and a procurement policy for addressing bicycle parking needs at all schools in the region.
- » Social media strategy in place to engage parents with support from municipalities and other local champions to promote messaging.
