

The project will strengthen existing active school travel programming in Ottawa through various initiatives including expanded outreach to parents and teachers; a new central website, student ambassador program and traffic management support for schools; and enhancements to an existing Walking School Bus program.

- » Developing a webinar series for teachers to promote active school travel benefits, resources and curriculum connections.
- » Introducing a Student Ambassador program to help strengthen a culture of walking in 19 school communities.
