Overview

Through this project a new active school travel (AST) facilitator is introducing School Travel Planning (STP) to area schools, strengthening awareness of and support for AST among key local stakeholders, and conducting evaluation of AST programs delivered by GreenUP.

Project highlights

- » Created new resources for promoting STP activities and new tools for engaging school community members including pop-up surveys and mapping activities.
- » Connected the STP process to school-based deep learning initiatives and community-based Jane's Walks to increase engagement.
