The project will build on previous School Travel Planning efforts and introduce a pilot Walking School Bus at select schools. Adopting an active school travel charter and related policy guide are also planned.

Project highlights

- » Walking School Buses have been introduced at 3 schools that are helping to increase students' physical activity and road safety skills as well as their parents' confidence in walking as an option for the school journey.
- » Beginning development of a best practice municipal policy guide to support active school travel in urban, suburban and rural communities.
