A community-tailored Walking School Bus pilot program, designed to address parent concerns and the challenges of active transportation in a rural setting. The pilot program will support a total of four school communities in Brockville, Smith Falls and Mississippi Mills.

Building on existing work through a multi-sectoral collaborative approach, an expanded School Travel Planning program, a Parent Engagement Strategy, and Site Plan Guidelines for Schools.

[London Active School Travel](#)

Expanded support for schools in the Thames Region by hiring a Travel Planner within the student transportation consortia. Deliverables include an Active School Travel Charter, an expanded School Travel Planning program, and Cycling Skills Training.

Expansion of Niagara Region's School Travel Planning program along with piloting a Walking School Bus model. Stakeholder coordination will be strengthened through a renewed advisory committee and adoption of an Active School Travel Charter.

A School Travel Planning program supporting ten schools, working across three school boards and aligned with the City of North Bay's Active Transportation Master Plan.

Increased local momentum for active school travel by hiring a full time coordinator to deliver School Travel Planning for Peterborough schools and strengthening stakeholder coordination and engagement.

Walk or Wheel Thunder Bay (WOW TBay)

Led by EcoSuperior Environmental Programs

Working collaboratively with a steering committee to support active school travel, delivering School Travel Planning (STP) in four local schools, and establishing an Active School Travel Charter.

Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph Active School Travel

Led by Service de transport Wellington Dufferin Student Transportation Services

Hiring a fulltime School Travel Coordinator, based in the student transportation consortia, to support School Travel Planning schools, pilot a Walking School Bus program, and develop a Municipal Policy Guide and an Active School Travel Charter for the Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph region.

Cambridge School Travel Planning

Led by the Student Transportation Services of Waterloo Region

Expanded School Travel Planning support for schools in the City of Cambridge, as part of a region-wide initiative that will seek systemic solutions for active student transportation.

Kitchener School Travel Planning

Led by the Student Transportation Services of Waterloo Region

Expanded School Travel Planning support for schools in the City of Kitchener, as part of a region-wide initiative that will seek systemic solutions for active student transportation.

Waterloo School Travel Planning
