Overview

The project will introduce School Travel Planning (STP) for the first time to schools in both the City of Brantford and County of Brant as well as strengthen a newly formed regional active school travel (AST) committee.

Project highlights

- » Members of the new Brantford-Brant Active Transportation for Schools (BATS) committee will work together to consolidate and build momentum around current initiatives. They will also foster a longer-term commitment to support walking and cycling to school including signing an AST charter.
- » BATS has identified 6 elementary school sites that will be the focus of enhanced AST initiatives as identified by their communities.
