Overview

The project will significantly expand School Travel Planning (STP) in Sarnia by appointing a facilitator to work with local schools and strengthening municipal and school board involvement in an existing active school travel advisory (AST) committee.

Project highlights

- » Undertaking comprehensive STP at up to five elementary schools including the adoption of AST charters at each.
- » Reviewing existing municipal and school board policies and making recommendations on changes that will help support and increase AST.
