Overview

Building on the lessons learned from an earlier School Travel Planning (STP) pilot, the project will hire a dedicated facilitator to work with all Stratford schools, in addition to developing a new active school travel toolkit.

Project highlights

- » Implementing STP at 8 out of 10 elementary schools within the city.
- » Formalizing and strengthening the work of an existing multi-stakeholder active school travel (AST) working group to ensure long-term sustainability of the project as well as to make policy recommendations to the city, school boards, health unit and police to better support AST.
