The project will expand a school wayfinding pilot project and strengthen existing School Travel Planning (STP) activities in the City of Toronto.

- » Installing wayfinding markings and signage along walking/cycling routes at three schools.
- » Delivering active transportation rodeos and student leadership training to build skills and leadership around safe walking and cycling.
- » Developing a communications plan and engaging with students, parents and teachers.
