Sufficient lighting along entirety of route to/from school (street and/or pedestrian lights)?			
Sufficient signs/markings/signals exist to direct pedestrians and drivers for safe activity?			
Are spaces that encourage loitering (alcoves, overgrown landscaping, etc.) present?			
Do road crossings have curb cuts and pavement markings to allow safe movement?			
Do busy intersections have crossing guards present to help children cross the road safely?			
Is the condition of sidewalk/path even and free of tripping hazards to ensure safe usage?
