### **Overview**

The project introduced School Travel Planning (STP) to local schools and strengthened a new regional active school travel (AST) committee.

## **Project highlights**

- » Implemented STP at six elementary schools and installed new bike and scooter racks at select locations.
- » Introduced wayfinding signage on a pilot basis at three schools in the County of Brant.
- » Members of the Brantford-Brant Active Transportation for Schools (BATS) committee worked to consolidate support for AST. This included laying the groundwork for adoption of an AST charter.
