Overview

Project partners worked to expand School Travel Planning (STP), develop new site plan guidelines for schools, pilot a parent engagement strategy, and conduct comprehensive data collection.

Project highlights

- » Completed 25 School Travel Plans and brought together principals to review implementation of their plans. Strengthened relationships have improved collection of student travel data.
- » Developed a new parent engagement strategy and tested a related toolkit at nine schools.
- » Finalising school site design guidelines to reduce the environmental footprint of new schools by reducing or eliminating paved areas such as bus loading zones, emergency routes, kiss-and-ride zones and on-site parking.
