Overview

Building on previous School Travel Planning (STP) work in the area, project partners developed a new Walking School Bus (WSB) program tailored for smaller rural communities as well as other resources to promote active travel to school.

Project highlights

- » Implemented STP at nine schools and established WSB routes in Brockville, Smiths Falls and Mississippi Mills.
- Implemented traffic calming measures to improve pedestrian safety in school zones.
- Developed an Active School Travel Charter that was endorsed by municipal, school board and public health stakeholders.
