Overview

Project partners collaborated to strengthen support for School Travel Planning(STP), pilot a walking school bus and expand existing initiatives including wayfinding signage, bike rack installations and cycling skills training.

Project highlights

- » A new position was created within Southwestern Ontario Student Transportation Services to support STP at select schools and serve as the point of contact on active transportation for other schools across the region.
- » New wayfinding signage was installed at six schools. Related promotional materials and an implementation guide were also developed.
- » Three schools participated in a Walking School Bus pilot project delivered in collaboration with the Canadian Cancer Society.
