Overview

Building on a previous pilot, the project introduced School Travel Planning to select schools across North Bay in alignment with the city's new Active Transportation Master Plan.

Project highlights

- » School-level surveys identified priorities including new bike racks, improved sidewalk maintenance and introduction of communal bus stops.
- » New engagement strategies strengthened parent involvement in promotional events.
- » Developed a new student-led model for delivering cycling safety training that connected youth from secondary and elementary schools.
