### Overview

Building on previous School Travel Planning (STP) efforts, the project engaged a dedicated Facilitator to work with all Stratford schools as well as develop a new active school travel (AST) toolkit.

### Project highlights

- » Nine of Stratford's 10 elementary schools participated in the project with five implementing STP with support from the Facilitator.
- » Developed a guide to help schools sustain STP.
- » Formalized a multi-stakeholder AST working group to ensure long-term sustainability as well as to make policy recommendations.
