Overview

The project expanded a previous school wayfinding pilot and strengthened existing School Travel Planning (STP) activities as part of the City's Vision Zero action plan.

Project highlights

- » Implemented STP at four schools.
- » Installed new wayfinding markings and signage along key walking and cycling routes to three schools.
- » Developed and delivered active transportation rodeos and student training initiatives to strengthen their STP skills and leadership.
