Overview

The project expanded School Travel Planning (STP) in the cities of Cambridge, Kitchener and Waterloo and developed other related initiatives to promote active school travel.

Project highlights

- » Implemented STP in 23 schools and introduced a new Kindergarten orientation package that emphasizes walking as the preferred option for travelling to school.
- » Developed a new "Sidewalk Smarts" pedestrian training program for grade 4 students including in-class and on-street components.
- » Created a guide to storing bikes, skateboards and scooters on school sites for use by school board planners and maintenance staff.
