### **Overview**

The project strengthened existing active school travel programming through various initiatives including expanded outreach to parents and teachers; new traffic management support for schools, and enhancements to an existing Walking School Bus program.

## **Project highlights**

- » Created a Walk to School Event Toolkit with standard resources to help staff, parents and students organize successful events in their school communities.
- » Developed new Walk a Block maps for all OCDSB and OCSB elementary and secondary schools to help reduce traffic volumes in school zones.
- » Obtained authorization for OSTA staff to issue municipal traffic tickets at some schools.
