#### **Overview**

The projected developed and tested a new tiered approach to active school travel (AST) program implementation. Another goal was to improve program sustainability at both the school and community levels.

# **Project highlights**

- » Piloted a tiered approach to increase AST at 9 schools with initiatives grouped into six categories: marketing & communication; classroom competition; wayfinding; engineering improvements; and Walking Wednesdays.
- » Developed a new "Family Connection" initiative to encourage and support families to walk to school together.
