Overview

The project expanded School Travel Planning (STP) by appointing a facilitator to work with local schools and strengthened stakeholder involvement in the local active school travel (AST) advisory committee.

Project highlights

- » Implemented STP at four schools including new traffic calming measures.
- » Developed an information package for principals about AST including available supports and risk management.
- » Conducted a review of municipal and school board policies with recommendations on changes to help support AST.
